## Results

We are extremely proud of this year's SATs results. The children throughout school have worked very hard. In year 6 up to 60% of the children achieved the expected level in reading, writing, grammar or mathematics.

These scores show that the children have made incredible progress whilst at New Bewerley.

In year 2 over 50% of the children achieved the expected level in reading, writing or mathematics.

65% of the children passed the phonics test in year 1 and 85% passed the phonics test by the end of year 2.

Approx. 50% achieved a Good Level of Development in reception.

All children have received their results and school's data will be published on the website in autumn.
