SATs Support

As the time for SATs is looming upon us, we are all working really hard to ensure that the children are adequately prepared to achieve their very best. In order to support the children, we have a number of things of offer:

- **Homework** that involves practise of the skills needed to complete the test. Spellings to learn for a test and a Maths booklet will be given out on a Monday each week. This needs to be completed by Friday and returned to school.
- **Buy CGP revision books.** These are on sale at school from either the class teachers or the office. The cost is a bargain price of £5 for 8 books. Working in these, little and often, will have a great benefit.
- **Clubs etc.** All the Year 6 teachers are providing extra interventions to support as many children as possible. This includes lunchtime homework clubs where children can complete their homework in a quiet environment and get help if needed.

Please encourage your child to access as many of these as possible in order to have a positive impact on our learning.

Swimming

Year 6 will be going swimming every Monday from Monday 23rd April. Please ensure children have a towel as well as swimming costume or shorts.

Attendance
